

2017 Rides to Remember Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All drivers shall conduct themselves according to the highest standards of behavior and sportsmanship particularly in their relationship with other drivers and officials, and in a manner that shall not be detrimental to the reputation of Ferrari Maserati of Atlanta or the Rides to Remember event.
- 2. All drivers must be licensed drivers and must abide by all federal, state and local laws, including, but not limited to speed limits and reckless driving.
- 3. Upon leaving the Ferrari Maserati of Atlanta dealership, all drivers must remain in a single line for the entirety of the convoy, until reaching Atlanta Motorsports Park (AMP).
- 4. At no point shall any driver separate from the convoy.
- 5. All drivers shall maintain a safe following distance from one another. By no means should "tailgating" occur.
- 6. All drivers should be committed to ensuring that this is a fun and safe experience for all of the children involved. Speeding, reckless driving or separating from the convoy will hinder the success and safety of the event.
- 7. No person under the age of 21 shall be permitted to use the road course at AMP without special authorization from one of the governing motorsports bodies such as SCCA, NASA or the successful completion of a recognized racing school sign off.
- 8. All drivers are required to wear their wristbands on their left arm at all times during the event.
- 9. All drivers certify that their cars are road ready and safe.
- 10. Speed limit while on the track with children as passengers is no greater than 70mph. Anyone exceeding this will be asked to leave the event.
